#### **Step 1:**The Creative Setup

#### Step 3: Sharing the Magic **♦**€

- 1. Place all the masks into a box.
- 2. On the board, write the questions: \*\*What? Why? And what makes it special for you?\*\*
- 3. Explain that each child will have to answer these questions based on the mask they pick from the box.

## **Step 5:**Reflection and Discussion ♀♀

#### 1. Ask the students:

- Were you able to see through your peer's eyes?
- Was it a breeze or a challenge?
- Show can this newfound skill of perspective-taking add to your life?
- 2. Ask the students to list their TOP 3 key takeaways from the activity.

## **Step 2:**Crafting Personalized Masks

- 1. Give the kids 3 minutes to cut out their masks.
- 2. Personalize the masks with something that represents them.
- 3. On the front, write their name and decorate as they wish.
- 4. On the back, write one thing that matters most to them, something they care about or like. (e.g., My pet dog, Playing soccer, Space).

# **Step 4:**Stepping into Each Other's Shoes

- 1. Allow children to pick a mask from the box.
- 2. In small groups, children step into each other's shoes and share the significance of the important thing on the mask they picked.
- 3. This is their magical journey into understanding their peers better!
